AREA A.—(a) To all Royal, Parliamentary and Police Burghs which had according to the most recent census a population over 12,000, and (b) to the following Special Lighting Districts, the boundaries of which have been defined, viz., Bellshill and Mossend, Blantyre, Cambuslang, and Larkhall, all in the County of Lanark, and the Vale of Leven in the County of Dumbarton.

AREA B.—To the whole of Scotland other than Area A.
