GLOUCESTER SWINE FEVER IN-
FECTED AREA ORDER OF 1923
(No. 3).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. The Gloucester Swine Fever Infected Area Order of 1923 shall be read and have effect as if the Infected Area described in the Schedule hereto were substituted for the Infected Area described in the Schedule to the Gloucester Swine Fever Infected Area Order of 1923 (No. 2).

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on

the fifteenth day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-three.

Revocation.

3. The Gloucester Swine Fever Infected Area Order of 1923 (No. 2) is hereby revoked.

Short Title.

4. This Order may be cited as the GLOUCESTER SWINE FEVER INFECTED AREA ORDER OF 1923 (No. 3), and shall be read with the Gloucester Swine Fever Infected Area Order of 1923.
