CALNE CORPORATION ELECTRICITY SPECIAL ORDER, 1923.

(Power to the Calne Town Council to Generate and Supply Electrical Energy for all purposes within the undermentioned Area of Supply; to use Lands for a Generating Station; to Break up Streets and lay down and erect Electric Lines, Wires, Posts and Apparatus; Rates and Charges; Incorporation of Acts; and other provisions.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Calne, in the County of Wilts, acting by the Council (hereinafter called "the Council"), intend to apply to the Electricity Commissioners on or before the 14th day of June instant for a Special Order (hereinafter called "the Order"), under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922, for all or some of the following amongst other purposes (that is to say):—

1. To authorize the Council to generate, store and supply electric energy for lighting, heating, power and all other purposes, public and private, as defined by the Electricity (Supply) Acts within the Borough of Calne and so much of the Parishes of Calne Without, Bremhill, Cherhill, Compton-Bassett, Hedington and Hilmarton as is within a radius of $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles from the principal entrance of the gas works of the Council (herein referred to as "the area of supply").

2. To authorize the Council to use certain lands for the purposes of the undertaking proposed to be authorized by the Order and thereon to construct a station and works, together with all such buildings, engines, batteries, dynamos, accumulators and other plant, machinery, apparatus, works and conveniences as may be necessary or suitable for generating electricity for the purpose of giving a supply under the Order.

3. The lands so proposed to be used for a generating station are as follow:—

4. To authorize the Council to take, collect and recover rents, rates and charges for the supply of electricity for lighting, power or other purposes and the use of any machines, lamps, meters, fittings or apparatus connected therewith, and to prescribe and limit the price to be charged therefor.

5. To incorporate with the Order the provisions contained in the Schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act, 1899.

6. The names of the roads in which it is proposed that electric lines shall be laid down within a specified time are as follows:—London Road (the portion within the Borough of Calne), High Street, Curzon Street, Wood Street, The Green, Mill Street, Church Street, Kingsbury Street, Horsebrook.
