**KETTERING ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION).**

**T**HE Urban District Council of Kettering (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), whose address is the Council Offices, High Street, Kettering, in the County of Northampton, are applying to the Electricity Commissioners, under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922, for a Special Order for the following objects, namely:—

1. To extend the area of supply under the Kettering Electric Lighting Order, 1896

(hereinafter called "the Order of 1896"), so as to include therein the Urban Districts of Market Harborough, Desborough and Rothwell, the Parish of Lubenham in the Rural District of Market Harborough, the Parishes of Brampton Ash, Braybrooke, Dingley and East Farndon in the Rural District of Oxendon, the Parishes of Barton Seagrave, Burton Latimer, Broughton, Cransley, Geddington, Loddington, Orton, Pytchley, Rushton, Thorpe Malsor, Warkton and Weekley in the Rural District of Kettering, the Parish of Isham in the Rural District of Wellingborough (the area so proposed to be added to the said area of supply being hereinafter referred to as "the added area").

2. To authorise the Council to generate, supply, distribute and sell electrical energy for all public and private purposes, as defined by the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922, within the added area.

3. To extend and make applicable to the added area all or some of the powers and provisions contained in the Order of 1896, and to apply such provisions to the Undertaking or Undertakings to be authorised by the Special Order, subject to such variations and exceptions as may be contained therein.

4. To incorporate in the Special Order such of the provisions contained in the Schedules to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act, 1899, as are applicable, and to apply such provisions to the Undertaking or Undertakings to be authorised by the Special Order, subject to such variations and exceptions as may be contained therein.

5. To alter, extend and amend the provisions of the Order of 1896 to some of these provisions.

6. To confer upon the Council all or some of the powers of the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922, and the enactments incorporated therewith, and to alter, vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might interfere with any of the objects of the Special Order, and to confer all other rights and privileges necessary for carrying such objects into effect.

7. To prescribe the maximum price or maximum prices that may be demanded and taken by the Council in respect of the supply of electrical energy within the added area.

8. The names of the streets and parts of streets in which electrical lines are to be laid down within a specified time are as follows:—

Urban District of Market Harborough.

St. Mary's Road from the Square to opposite the Railway Station entrance, Adam and Eve Street, Church Street, High Street, Leicester Road from High Street to a point opposite the house known as "Rose Hill," Coventry Road from the Square to Logan Street, the Square, Northampton Road from the Square to Caxton Street.

Urban District of Desborough.

Station Road, High Street from Victoria Street to Harborough Road, Rushton Road from Regent Street to Union Street, Union Street from King Street to Rushton Road.

Urban District of Rothwell.

Kettering Road, High Street, Bridge Street, Market Hill.

Parish of Burton Latimer.

High Street from Station Road to Duke Street, Church Street from the Cross to the
