

ARTICLE 4.

The present Convention shall be ratified and the ratifications shall be exchanged at London as soon as possible. It shall come into operation ten days after its publication, in conformity with the laws of the High Contracting Parties and shall remain in force as long as the Extradition Treaty between Great Britain and Belgium of the 29th October, 1901, and shall lapse with the termination of that Treaty.

In witness whereof the respective Plenipotentiaries have signed the present Convention and have affixed thereto their seals.

Done in duplicate at London, the 8th day of August, 1923.

ARTICLE 4.

La présente Convention sera ratifiée et les ratifications seront échangées à Londres le plus tôt possible. Elle entrera en vigueur dix jours après sa publication dans les formes prescrites par la législation des Hautes Parties contractantes et restera en vigueur aussi longtemps que le Traité d'Extradition du 29 octobre 1901 entre la Belgique et la Grande-Bretagne et cessera d'exister en même temps que ce Traité.

And whereas the ratifications of the above Convention were exchanged at London on the 15th day of October, 1923 :

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, and in virtue of the authority committed to Him by the said recited Acts, doth order, and it is hereby ordered, that from and after the 1st day of February, 1924, the said Acts shall apply in the case of Belgium under and in accordance with the said Treaty of the 29th October, 1901, and the supplementary Conventions of the 5th March, 1907, the 3rd March, 1911, and the 8th August, 1923 :

Provided always that the operation of the said Acts shall be and remain suspended within the Dominion of Canada so long as an Act of the Parliament of Canada, being Part I of Chapter 155 of the Revised Statutes of Canada, 1906, and entitled "An Act respecting the Extradition of Fugitive Criminals," shall continue in force there, and no longer.

This Order may be cited as the "Belgium (Extradition) Order in Council, 1924."

UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE
ACT, 1923.

*Clare College, Cambridge.
Gonville and Caius College, Cambridge.*

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of the above Act, that amending Statutes approved by the University of Cambridge Commissioners on the 15th January 1924, for Clare College, Cambridge, and Gonville and Caius College, Cambridge, have been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council.

The Statute in relation to Clare College alters Statute 25 of the said College by substituting in the twelfth paragraph the words

"thirty-first day of July" for the words
"twenty-ninth day of September."

The Statute in relation to Gonville and Caius College substitutes an amended Statute for Statute 31 (Retirement and Pensions of Officers), and adds certain sections to Statute 40 (Application and Distribution of Property and Income) of the Statutes of the said College.
