The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:-

Contraction of certain Infected Areas.

1. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1924 (No. 67) shall be read and have effect as if the Areas Nos. 1 and 3 described in the Schedule to this Order were substituted respectively for the Infected Areas Nos. 1 and 3 described in the First Schedule to that Order.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the thirtieth day of April, nineteen hundred and twenty-four.

Short Title.

3. This Order may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF Foot-and-Mouth Disease; and I also undertake to indemnify the Minister against any claim for such compensation for slaughter in excess of such sum as aforesaid which may be made by any other person.
