

inhabitants thereof and it has been made to appear to us that it would promote the interests of religion that the particular portions of the said New Parish of The Martyrs, Leicester, and of the said Parish of Braunstone which are hereinafter mentioned and described should be constituted a separate District in the manner which is hereinafter set forth :

“ And whereas there is not at present within the limits of the said proposed separate District any consecrated Church or Chapel in use for the purposes of Divine Worship :

“ And whereas we have agreed to make and pay out of the Common Fund created by the firstly herein mentioned Act a grant of £200 per annum to the Minister of the said proposed separate District so soon as a Minister shall have been duly licensed in accordance with the provisions of the secondly herein mentioned Act and to his successors :

“ And whereas the said grant of the said yearly sum of £200 will, after the publication in the London Gazette of an Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme, be made and secured by an Instrument to be executed by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, under our Common Seal in accordance with the provisions of the Act of the 29th and 30th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 111 :

“ And whereas there has been contributed and paid to the credit of our account at the Bank of England a capital sum of £3,000 towards the cost of erecting a permanent Church for the said proposed separate District :

“ And whereas the said capital sum of £3,000 has been contributed and paid as aforesaid upon the understanding and condition that (such arrangement appearing to us to be expedient) the whole right of Patronage of the said proposed District, and, when such District shall have become a New Parish, then of the said New Parish, and the nomination of the Minister or Incumbent thereof should be assigned in the manner which is hereinafter set forth :

“ And whereas the contributors of the said capital sum of £3,000 towards the cost of erecting such permanent Church have nominated to us, as the persons to whom they desire that the whole right of Patronage of the said proposed District or New Parish should be assigned, the Peterborough Diocesan Trustees (Registered) for ever to the intent that at the first and every subsequent turn of presentation they shall present such Minister as shall be nominated to them by the Bishop for the time being of the Diocese within which the said proposed District or New Parish is or shall hereafter be situate and the Principal for the time being of Ridley Hall, Cambridge :

“ Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Cyril Charles Bowman, Bishop of Peterborough (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly recommend and propose that all those portions of the said New Parish of The Martyrs, Leicester, and of the said Parish of Braunstone, which are described in the Schedule hereunder written, all which portions, together with the boundaries thereof, are delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed, shall, upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your

Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme as aforesaid become and be constituted a separate District for spiritual purposes, and that the same shall be named ‘ The District of The Holy Apostles, Leicester.’

“ And we further recommend and propose that the whole right of Patronage of the said District so recommended to be constituted, and, when such District shall have become a New Parish as aforesaid, then of the said New Parish, and the nomination of the Minister or Incumbent thereof shall without any assurance in the law other than this Scheme and any duly gazetted Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying the same and upon and from the day of the date of the publication of such Order in the London Gazette as aforesaid be assigned to and be absolutely vested in the Peterborough Diocesan Trustees (Registered) for ever to the intent that at the first and every subsequent turn of presentation they shall present such Minister as shall be nominated to them by the Bishop for the time being of the Diocese within which the said District or New Parish is or shall hereafter be situate and the Principal for the time being of Ridley Hall, Cambridge.

“ And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts, or of any of them, or of any other Act of Parliament.

“ The SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme has reference.

“ The District of The Holy Apostles, Leicester, comprising :—

“ I. All that portion of the New Parish (some-time District) of The Martyrs, Leicester, in the County of Leicester and in the Diocese of Peterborough, which is bounded upon the south east by the New Parish of All Souls, Leicester, upon the south west by the Parish of Braunstone, upon the north partly by the Extra Parochial Liberty called Braunstone Frith, partly by the New Parish of Saint Augustine, New Found Pool, and partly by a detached portion of the Parish of Saint Mary, Leicester, all in the said County and Diocese, and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the north east, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said detached portion of the Parish of Saint Mary, Leicester, from the said New Parish of The Martyrs, Leicester, at the centre of the bridge which carries Hinckley Road across the Leicester and Burton Branch Line of the London, Midland and Scottish Railway, and extending thence south eastward along the middle of the said line of railway for a distance of 1 mile and 42 chains or thereabouts to a point in the middle of the viaduct which carries such line of railway across the River Soar upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of The Martyrs, Leicester, from the said New Parish of All Souls, Leicester.

“ II. And also all that contiguous portion of the said Parish of Braunstone which is bounded upon the north by the above described portion of the said New Parish of The Martyrs, Leicester, upon the north east partly by the said New Parish of All Souls, Leicester, and partly by the Parish of Aylestone, in the said County and Diocese, upon the east and upon the south by the said Parish of Aylestone, and
