APPOINTMENTS OF STANDINGS FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES WITHIN THE METROPOLITAN POLICE DISTRICT, AND REGULATIONS TO BE OBSERVED.

I, WILLIAM THOMAS FRANCIS HORWOOD, the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby appoint Standings for Hackney Carriages at the several places hereinafter mentioned; for such number of carriages at each Standing as specified, and within the boundaries set forth for each Standing, provided that no Hackney Carriage shall be suffered to stand across any street or carriage-way, or upon any place where foot passengers usually cross the carriage-way.

GOLDHAWK ROAD AND ROCKLEY ROAD, SHEPHERDS BUSH. Twenty-four vehicles:

In three portions, viz. :-

First Portion.—Twelve carriages at Goldhawk Road, North side of roadway, commencing at a point 14 yards West of Cabmen's Shelter at Eastern end of Shepherds Bush Green, extending Westward as far as necessary for twelve carriages. Front of vehicles toward the East.
