FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (IN-  
FECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1924  
(No. 125).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Declaration of Further Infected Area.*

1. The Area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be an Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1924 (No. 70).

*Short Title.*

2. This Order may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1924 (No. 125), and shall be read with the Order referred to in Article 1.

*Further Infected Area.*

An Area comprising:—

*In the county of Kent.*

The city and county borough of Canterbury.

The boroughs of Hythe, Tenterden, Lydd, New Romney, Folkestone and Faversham.

The petty sessional divisions of Ashford (including its detached part), Cranbrook (*except the parishes of Marden, Horsmunden, Goudhurst, Sandhurst, Hawkhurst, and Newenden*), Bearsted (*except the parishes of Boxley, Bredhurst, Detling, Thornham, Bearsted, East Barming. West Barming, East Farleigh, Loose, Linton and Boughton Monchelsea*), Romney Marsh (including its detached part), Elham (including its detached parts), Faversham (including its detached parts) and St Augustine (*except the parishes of Herne Bay, Herne, Reculver, Hoath and Chislet*), the detached part of the petty sessional division of Sittingbourne and the parishes of Borden, Bredgar, Tunstall, Sittingbourne, Murston, Tonge, Bapchild, Rodmersham, Kingsdown, Milsted, Littlebourne, Ickham and Well, Adisham, Bishopsbourne, Kingston, Barham, Denton, Wootton, Womenswold, Sibertswold, Lydden, Swingfield, Alkham and Capel le ferne, and including any detached parts of such parishes.
