URBAN DISTRICT OF KETTERING.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1907.

NOTICE is hereby given that by an Order dated the 3rd day of July, 1924, the Minister of Health has declared that, on and after the 25th day of August, 1924, the following provisions of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, shall be in force in the Urban District of Kettering, namely:—

- Sections 21 to 24 (inclusive), 26 and 33, comprised in Part II (streets and buildings);
- Sections 44 and 49 to 51 (inclusive), comprised in Part III (sanitary provisions);
- Sections 59, 62, 65 and 68, comprised in Part IV (Infectious Diseases);
- Part V (common lodging houses);
- Part VI (recreation grounds); and
- Part X (miscellaneous provisions).

The above provisions are declared to be in force subject, as regards Sections 23, 59 and 75, to the conditions specified in the Order.
