Alteration of Boundaries.

Notice is hereby given, that the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries has prepared a draft Order, under the Land Drainage Act, 1918, for the amendment of the Welland Drainage Order, 1922, by reducing the rate leviable on lands in Area "D" of the above Drainage District until such time as an effective scheme of works for the improvement of the outfall of the River Welland shall be undertaken, and extending the area of the Drainage District by the inclusion therein of certain lands situate in the Parish of Holbeach at present admitted into the Welland Drainage Outfall District.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 24TH JULY, 1924.)

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1924 (No. 130).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Extension of Infected Area.

1. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1924 (No. 127), shall be read and have effect as if such part of the parish of Towcester as lies to the north of the railway from Wappenham to Stoke Bruerne were included in and formed part of the Infected Area No. 5, described in the First Schedule to that Order.

Amendment of Previous Order.

2. The provision of Article 1 of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1924 (No. 127), relating to the movement of animals into a specified Infected Area shall be read and have effect as if it referred to Area No. 11, described in the First Schedule to that Order, and not to Area No. 8, described in the said Schedule.

Short Title.

3. This Order may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1924 (No. 130).
