PINKERS.—The Proposed General Minimum Time-Rates for Female Pinkers shall be the rates proposed as set out in Section I above with the addition thereto of 1d. per hour in each case.

SECTION III.

CHOPPERS.—The Proposed General Minimum Time-Rates for Female Choppers shall be the rates proposed as set out in Section I above, with the addition thereto of $\frac{1}{2}d$. per hour in each case.

PART II.

PROPOSED VARIATION OF PIECE-WORK BASIS TIME RATES.

The Proposed Piece-Work Basis Time-Bates for Female Piece-Workers of 18 years of age and over in the Cerement-Making Section of the Trade shall be 1*d*. per hour higher than the appropriate General Minimum Time-Bate as proposed and set out or referred to in Sections I, II and III of Part I of this Schedule.
