The General Minimum Time-Rates set out in Parts I and II of this Schedule are weekly rates based on a week of 48 hours and are subject to a proportionate adjustment according as the number of hours of employment in any week is less than 48.

PART V.

GENERAL MINIMUM PIECE-RATES FOR FEMALE WORKERS EMPLOYED ON HESSIAN WEAVING [(AS DEFINED IN PART VI, SECTION III) IN THE AREAS OF ABERDEEN, BARROW-IN-FURNESS, DUNDEE, AND TAYPORT (AS DEFINED IN PART VIII)].

SECTION I.

GENERAL MINIMUM PIECE-RATES FOR STANDARD FABRIC AS DEFINED IN PART VI, SECTION I.

- (a) For Single Loom Weavers (as defined in Part VI, Section I (a)), the general minimum piece-rate for weaving the standard length of the standard fabric of the standard width (as defined in Part VI, Section I (c), (d) and (e)), hereinafter referred to as the STANDARD GENERAL MINIMUM PIECE-RATE, is ... .. 39½d.
- (b) For Double Loom Weavers (as defined in Part VI, Section I (b)), the general minimum piece-rate for weaving the standard length of the standard fabric of the standard width (as defined in Part VI, Section I (c), (d) and (e)), hereinafter referred to as the STANDARD GENERAL MINIMUM PIECE-RATE, is ... .. } 15 per cent. less than the Standard General Minimum Piece-Rate for Single Loom Weavers.

Provided that in cases where variation on the Standard General Minimum Piece Rate has to be made in respect of both Porter and Shots, the variations for Porter and Shots shall not be made separately but as follows, that is to say, the sum or difference, as the case may be, of the appropriate percentage figures set out in the Table for Porter and Shots respectively shall first be calculated, and the Standard General Minimum Piece-Rate shall then be varied by the application thereto of the percentage figure so arrived at.
