from wages in respect of contributions to any superannuation or other provident fund.

Note.—The employment of women, young persons and children is subject to the provisions of the Factory and Workshop Acts, the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, 1920, and the Education Act, 1921.

PROPOSAL TO FIX GENERAL MINIMUM PIECE-RATES AND GUARANTEED TIME-RATES AND TO VARY GENERAL MINIMUM TIME-RATES AND OVERTIME RATES FOR CERTAIN CLASSES OF MALE WORKERS EMPLOYED ON HESSIAN WEAVING (AS DEFINED IN PART I OF THE SCHEDULE TO THIS NOTICE).

In accordance with Regulations made under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, by the Minister of Labour, and dated 31st October, 1918, the Trade Board established in Great Britain under the Trade Boards Acts, 1909 and 1916, for the Jute Trade, as specified in the Trade Boards (Jute) Order, 1919, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE, as required by Section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, that they PROPOSE TO FIX General Minimum Piece-Rates and Guaranteed Time-Rates for certain classes of Male Weavers in Great Britain, and TO VARY the Overtime Rates and General Minimum Time-Rates at present fixed and set out in the Trade Board's Notice J. (35) dated 26th September, 1924, in their application to such workers, the proposed minimum rates being as shown in the Schedule set out below. proposed minimum rates being as shown in the Schedule set out below.

### SCHEDULE.

### PART I.

PROPOSED GENERAL MINIMUM PIECE-RATES FOR MALE WORKERS EMPLOYED ON HESSIAN WEAVING (AS HEREINAFTER DEFINED).

#### SECTION I.

The proposed General Minimum Piece-Rates to apply to Male Workers employed on Hessian Weaving in any part of Great Britain shall be the General Minimum Piece-Rates at present fixed for female workers employed on Hessian Weaving as set out in Parts V and VI of the Schedule to the Trade Board's Notice J. (35) dated 26th September, 1924.

#### SECTION II.

The proposed General Minimum Piece-Rates shall apply to the weaving of all Hessian, floor-cloth and linoleum goods, other than those woven in looms the reed space of which is 32 inches or narrower.
