of the return of the first Member elected at the first general election held under this Order, if it shall not have been sooner dissolved; and thereafter shall dissolve the Council at the expiration of five years from the date of the publication in the said Gazette of the return of the first Member elected at the last preceding general election, if it shall not have been sooner dissolved.

LII. The first general election of members of the Council shall be held at such time not more than six months after the coming into operation of this Order, and a general election shall be held at such time within two months after every dissolution of the Council as the Governor shall by proclamation appoint.

LIII. Minutes shall be regularly kept of all the proceedings of the Council, and at each meeting of the Council the Minutes of the last preceding meeting shall be confirmed or amended, as the case may require, before proceeding to the despatch of any other business. The Governor shall transmit to His Majesty through a Secretary of State as soon as possible after every meeting a full and exact copy of the Minutes thereof.

LIV. This Order shall be published in the Trinidad Royal Gazette, and shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by the Governor by Proclamation in the said Gazette; and the Governor shall give directions for the publication of this Order at such places and in such manner and for such time or times as he thinks proper for giving due publicity thereto within the Colony.

LV. His Majesty hereby reserves to Himself, His Heirs and Successors, full power and authority from time to time to revoke, alter, or amend this Order as to Him, or Them, shall seem fit.

And the Right Honourable James Henry Thomas, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, is to give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
