MOTOR CAR ACT, 1903.

COUNTY OF SURREY.

Whereas by sub-section 1 of Section 9 of the Motor Car Act, 1903, it is enacted that within any limits or place referred to in regulations made by the Local Government Board with a view to the safety of the public on the application of the Local Authority of the area in which the limits or place are situate, a person shall not drive a motor car at a speed exceeding ten miles per hour;

And whereas the power to make such regulations has been transferred to the Minister of Transport;

And whereas by a regulation dated the 17th day of November, 1923, made by the Minister of Transport, the above-mentioned provisions of the said sub-section were applied, for a period of twelve months from the 1st day of December, 1923, within the limits comprising the following roads and parts of roads within the Urban District of Sutton, that is to say:— So much of High Street and Brighton Road as extends from the entrance to the Gas Works Yard about 40 yards couth of Burnell Road to a point 100 yards south of Devonshire Avenue; and so much of Carshalton Road
