

BUTTON MAKING TRADE BOARD (GREAT BRITAIN).

PROPOSAL TO VARY THE GENERAL MINIMUM TIME-RATES AND OVERTIME RATES FOR MALE WORKERS UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE IN THE ERINOID BUTTON SECTION OF THE TRADE.

In accordance with Regulations made under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, by the Minister of Labour, and dated 31st October, 1918, and 1st August, 1922, respectively, the Trade Board established under the Trade Boards Acts, 1909 and 1918, in Great Britain for the branches of trade as specified in the Trade Boards (Button Making) Order, 1919, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE as required by Section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, that they PROPOSE TO VARY the General Minimum Time-Rates and Overtime Rates at present effective and set out in the Trade Board's Notice V. (12), dated 3rd January, 1924, in their application to MALE WORKERS under 21 years of age in the Erinoid Button Section of the Trade, the Minimum Rates as proposed being as shown in the Schedule below.

SCHEDULE.

MALE WORKERS UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE employed in the ERINOID BUTTON SECTION of the TRADE.

PART I.

PROPOSED GENERAL MINIMUM TIME-RATES.

SECTION I.

Male Learners (as defined in, and whose employment complies with the conditions set out in, Part III of this Schedule) employed in the Erinoid Button Section of the Trade :

- (a) Learners of 18 and under 21 years of age employed in Stamping, Burnishing, Spinning (including Setting), Dipping, Staining, Sawing, Turning or Cutting (other than Cutting on Wet Lathes) :—

	Per hour.
Learners of 20 and under 21 years of age	11½d.
" " 19 " 20 " " 	9d.
" " 18 " 19 " " 	8d.

- (b) Learners of 18 and under 21 years of age other than workers included in Sub-Section (a) above :—

Learners of 20 and under 21 years of age	11d.
" " 19 " 20 " " 	10d.
" " 18 " 19 " " 	9½d.

- (c) Learners under 18 years of age :—

Learners of 17 and under 18 years of age	7d.
" " 16 " 17 " " 	5d.
" " 15 " 16 " " 	4d.
,, under 15 years of age	3d.

SECTION II.

Male Workers under 21 years of age employed in the Erinoid Button Section of the Trade other than Male Learners included in Section I above.

Workers of 18 and under 21 years of age	1s. 1½d.
" " 16 " 18 " " 	8d.
,, under 16 years of age	6d.

PART II.

PROPOSED OVERTIME RATES.

Overtime Rates calculated on the minimum rates of wages specified in Part I of this Schedule in the manner set out in Part III of the Schedule to the Trade Board's Notice V. (12) dated 3rd January, 1924, shall apply in substitution for the rates set out in Part I of this Schedule in respect of all time worked in excess of the number of hours declared by the Trade Board in Part III of the Schedule to the above mentioned Notice V. (12) to be the normal number of hours of work in the trade.
