#### COAL MINES ACT, 1911

##### SECTION 33.—SAFETY LAMPS.

Lieutenant-Colonel G. R. Lane-Fox, M.P., Secretary for Mines, gives notice that on the 24th November, 1924, he made an Order under Section 33 of the Coal Mines Act, 1911, approving for use in all mines to which the Act applies, subject to the conditions specified in the Schedule to the Order, the following types of Safety Lamps, viz.:—

“ Davis-Jackson ” Lamp;  
“ Derby ” Miners’ Electric Hand Lamp;  
“ Ceag ” Pillarless Lamp No. 2;  
“ Ceag ” 4 Volt Pillarless Lamp;  
“ Cambrian ” Electric Lamps, Types A and B;  
“ Oldham ” Electric Lamp Torch;  
Wolf Alkaline Lamps Nos. 966 and 969.

The Order also amends the Schedules to previous Safety Lamps Orders by substituting revised specifications, or amending the specifications of certain types of safety lamps already approved.
