ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 16TH DECEMBER, 1924.)

FOOT - AND - MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1924 (No. 180).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows :—

Release of Certain Areas from Restrictions.

1. Infected Areas Nos. 1 and 4 described in the Schedule to the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1924 (No. 177) shall cease to be Infected Areas for the purpose of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1924 (No. 164).

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-second day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty-four.

Short Title.

3. This Order may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1924 (No. 180).
