THE UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACTS, 1877-1923.

The following Statutes made by the Governing Body of Trinity College, Cambridge, on the 22nd November, 1924, the Governing Body of Christ's College, Cambridge, on the 24th November, 1924, and the Chancellor, Masters, and Scholars of the University of Cambridge, on the 19th December, 1924, and approved by the University of Cambridge Commissioners on the 14th January, 1925, have been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of their having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923":—

TRINITY COLLEGE, CAMBRIDGE.

STATUTES to alter and amend the Statutes of Trinity College in the University of Cambridge, which amending Statutes were duly made at a College Meeting being a Meeting of the Governing Body of the College specially summoned for this purpose held on the twenty-second day of November, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, and having been passed at such Meeting by the votes of more than two-thirds of the number of persons present and voting, and having been approved by the University of

Cambridge Commissioners, under "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923" (13 and 14 George V., Chapter 33), which approval is testified by the Common Seal of the Commissioners being hereunto affixed, are now submitted for the approval of His Majesty the King in Council.

WE, The Master, Fellows and Scholars of Trinity College, in the University of Cambridge, in exercise of the powers given to us by the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1877, and by the 11th Section of the Schedule to the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, Do hereby alter and amend the existing Statutes of our said College, in manner following, that is to say:—

I. By adding after section 9a of Statute XV intituled "Tenure and Vacating of Fellowships" the following section to form a new section 9b of the same Statute:—

9b. The Council shall have power to enter into an agreement with any Fellow holding a qualifying office who shall have held that or some other qualifying office before the 25th day of January, 1924, whereby such Fellow shall agree in consideration of any payments made or to be made by the College to him or for his benefit or of any rights under the Federated Superannuation System for Universities secured to him by such payments to surrender his actual or contingent rights or claims to a fellowship dividend on retirement from any qualifying
