Confirmation of Regulations.

- 2.—(1) Regulations made under this Order shall not take effect unless and until they have been submitted to and confirmed by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries.
- (2) A copy of any Regulations made by a Local Authority under this Order, signed and certified by the Clerk of that Local Authority to be a true copy and to have been duly confirmed shall be evidence, until the contrary is proved, in all legal proceedings, of the due making, confirmation and existence of the Regulations, without further or other proof.

# Seizure of Dogs where Regulations are Contravened.

3. Any dog in respect of which an offence is being committed against a Regulation made under this Order may be seized and treated as a stray dog under the powers conferred by Section three of the Dogs Act, 1906.

## Extension of Definition in Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.

4. Dogs shall be animals for the purposes of the following sections of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894 (namely):—

Section forty-three (powers of police)
Section forty-four (powers of inspectors);
and also for the purposes of all other sections
of the said Act containing provisions relative
to or consequent on the provisions of those
sections and this Order, including such sections
as relate to offences and legal proceedings.

Local Authority to enforce Order.

5. The provisions of this Order shall be executed and enforced by the Local Authority.

#### Short Title.

6. This Order may be cited as the STIRLING-SHIRE (CONTROL OF DOGS) ORDER OF 1925. In witness whereof the Official Seal of the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries is hereunto affixed this ninth day of February, nineteen hundred and twenty-five.
