WATER UNDERTAKINGS (MODIFICATION OF
CHARGES) ACT, 1921.

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the city of Chichester have made application to the Minister of Health under the above Act for an Order modifying Sections 20 and 21 of the Chichester Corporation Water Act, 1897, and paragraph 8 of the Agreement scheduled to the Selsey Water Act, 1907, so as to enable them to make charges for water supply for domestic and other purposes in the water limits within which they are empowered to supply water in accordance with the following scale:—

To increase the water charges under Sections 20 and 21 of the Chichester Corporation Water Act, 1897, by 50 per cent., and to increase the price to be paid by the

Selsey Water Company to the Corporation under paragraph 8 of the Agreement scheduled to the Selsey Water Act, 1907, by 100 per cent.

A copy of the application and of all documents submitted to the Minister in connection therewith may be inspected and extracts thereof made free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, East Street, in the said city, on any week day between the hours of 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. (Saturdays 10 a.m. and 1 p.m.).

ISLE OF WIGHT RURAL ELECTRICITY SPECIAL
ORDER 1925.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Isle of Wight Electric Light and Power Company Limited (hereinafter called "The Company") whose registered office is at The Electricity Works, Ventnor, Isle of Wight, has applied to the Electricity Commissioners under the provisions of the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1922 for a Special Order for the following purposes:—

1.—(a) To authorise the Company to generate and distribute electricity for public and private purposes as defined by the said Acts, within the whole of the Rural District of the Isle of Wight excepting the parishes of Northwood, Carisbrooke and Bonchurch (hereinafter called "the area of supply").

(b) To authorise the Company to exercise within the area of supply the powers usually conferred on distributors of electrical energy and

(c) To authorise the St. Helens Electric Lighting Company Limited to sell and transfer to and the Company to purchase and take a transfer of the Undertaking authorised by the St. Helens (Isle of Wight) Electric Lighting Order 1900.

2. The names of the streets or parts of streets in which it is proposed that electric lines shall be laid down within a specified time are as follows:—

In the Parish of St. Lawrence:—

The main road between the boundary of the Ventnor Urban District and the boundary of the parish of Whitwell.
