The KING has been graciously pleased to give and grant unto Hubert Edward Madden Bourke, otherwise Hubert Edward Madden Bourke-Borrowes, of Gilttown, in the County of Kildare, Esquire, His Majesty's Royal Licence and Authority, bearing date at St. James' the ninth day of March, 1925, that he, the said Hubert Edward Madden Bourke and his issue, may assume and take and henceforth use the surname of Bourke-Borrowes instead of that of Bourke, and bear the arms of Borrowes as his and their principal Arms quartered with those of Bourke.

Provided that His Majesty's Royal Concession and Declaration be recorded in the office of Ulster King of Arms in Ireland, which has been done accordingly.
