

The Minister of Transport proposes to confirm the Order and gives notice that any person affected who may be desirous of objecting to the confirmation of the same must in accordance with the Electricity (Confirmation of Special Orders) Rules, 1921, do so by memorial addressed to the Minister of Transport written on one side only of foolscap paper and sent by registered post addressed to The Secretary, Ministry of Transport, 6, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1, and posted not later than the 13th day of May, 1925. COUNTY BOROUGH OF WEST HARTLEPOOL.

WEST HARTLEPOOL CORPORATION ACT, 1919.

WHEREAS by Section 23 (1) of the West Hartlepool Corporation Act, 1919, it is provided that the Corporation of West Hartlepool (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") may, with the consent of the Board of Trade and the local authority of the district and the road authority of any road along the route, run omnibuses along any route outside the Borough;

And whereas the power to give such consent has been transferred to the Minister of Transport;
