

INDIAN CIVIL SERVICE.

Regulations for competitive examinations held in India:—

In Rule 8 after the words " British Subject " where they first occur, it is proposed to insert the words " of Indian domicile."

For Rule 12 which at present is as follows:—

" (12) A candidate must hold a degree of a University incorporated by law in British India or of the Mysore University or the Senior Diploma of the Mayo College, Ajmere."

it is proposed to substitute the following:—

" (12) A candidate must hold a degree of a University approved by the Governor-General in Council, or the Senior Diploma of the Mayo College, Ajmere."

It is intended that the amended Rules shall come into operation for the competitive examinations to be held in India in 1926 and subsequent years.

THE LONDON TRAFFIC (RESTRICTED STREETS) REGULATIONS, 1925.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport, by virtue and in exercise of the powers given to him by Section 7 of the London Traffic Act, 1924, and the London Traffic (Restricted Streets) Regulations, 1925, after consulting the London and Home Counties Traffic Advisory Committee, has relaxed the restrictions and limitations imposed by Regulation 2 of the said Regulations upon the occasion of the Race Meeting to be held at Epsom on Tuesday the 26th, Wednesday the 27th, Thursday the 28th, and Friday the 29th days of May, 1925, so that nothing in the said Regulations shall prevent any person maintaining at the date of this notice a regular service in accordance with Section 6 of the London Traffic Act, 1924, upon approved route numbered 180 from using on those days in any of the restricted streets or parts thereof described in the Schedule hereto any number of omnibuses not exceeding twice the number which he may use in that street or part thereof under the said Regulation 2: Provided that nothing herein contained shall be deemed to affect or derogate from the powers of the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis under the provisions of Section 52 of the Metropolitan Police Act, 1839, to give directions to constables for keeping order and for preventing any obstruction of the thoroughfares.
