### NON-CONTENTIOUS PROBATE RULES.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that the President of the Probate, Divorce and Admiralty Division of the High Court of Justice, with the concurrence of the Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice

of England proposes to make Rules for regulating the procedure and practice of the High Court in regard to non-contentious or common form probate business.

1. For the purposes of the Administration of Estates Act, 1925, and the Administration of Justice Act, 1925,

(a) Amending Rules Nos. 30, 37, 39, 50, 62, 66 and 76 of the Principal Probate Registry Non-Contentious Rules, and Rules Nos. 36, 43, 46, 61, 72, 74, 75 and 89 of the District Registries Non-Contentious Probate Rules.
