Provided that in the case of workers under 21 years of age the minimum rates set out above shall apply to such workers when employed in machine tackling notwithstanding that they may not be engaged in the whole of the operations specified in the definition of a Machine Tackler as set out below.

\* The proposed weekly rates set out above are based on a week of 48 hours and are subject to a proportionate decrease according as the number of hours of employment in any week is less than 48.
