#### NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1924.

#### ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 29TH DECEMBER, 1925.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:

#### Authorisation of Sales at Reading.

- Notwithstanding anything contained in the Midlands and South of England (Regulation of Movement of Animals) Order of 1925, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order," the holding of Sales by Messrs. John Thornton and Company at the Cattle Market, in the county borough of Reading, on the sixth and thirteenth days of January, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, is hereby authorised subject to the conditions hereinafter specified.
