must be made upon the prescribed Forms and lodged with this Department in order to rank for payment of the fifth dividend to be declared by me out of the funds in my hands arising from the liquidation of the abovementioned property rights and interests belonging to nationals of the former Kingdom of Hungary or received by me from the Hungarian Clearing Office under paragraph 11 of the Annex to Article 231 of the abovementioned Treaty in pursuance of the Agreement between His Majesty's Government and the Hungarian Government of the 20th December, 1921, respecting the settlement of Enemy Debts referred to in Section III of Part X of the above-mentioned Treaty, or arising out of any other available property.
