

## TRADE BOARDS ACTS, 1909 AND 1918.

STAMPED OR PRESSED METAL WARES TRADE BOARD  
(GREAT BRITAIN).

PROPOSAL TO VARY THE GENERAL MINIMUM TIME RATES, PIECE-WORK BASIS  
TIME RATE AND OVERTIME RATES FOR FEMALE WORKERS EMPLOYED  
AS DIPPERS.

In accordance with Regulations made under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, by the Minister of Labour, and dated 31st October, 1918, and 1st August, 1922, respectively, the Trade Board established under the Trade Boards Acts, 1909 and 1918, in Great Britain for the Stamped or Pressed Metal Wares Trade as specified in the Appendix to the Trade Boards (Stamped or Pressed Metal Wares) Order, 1924, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they PROPOSE TO VARY the General Minimum Time Rates, Piece-Work Basis Time Rates and Overtime Rates for female workers set out in their Notice Q. (30) dated 16th May, 1925, in their application to female workers employed as Dippers, the Minimum Rates proposed for female workers employed as Dippers being as set out in the Schedule below.

## PART II.

PROPOSED OVERTIME RATES FOR FEMALE WORKERS EMPLOYED AS DIPPERS.

As respects female workers employed as Dippers for whom Variations of the General Minimum Time Rates and Piece-Work Basis Time Rate are proposed in Part I above, Overtime Rates calculated on the Proposed Minimum Rates specified in Part I of this Schedule, in the manner set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Notice Q. (30), issued by the Trade Board and dated 16th May, 1925, shall apply in substitution for the proposed Minimum Rates otherwise applicable as set out in Part I of this Schedule, in respect of all hours worked in excess of the number of hours declared by the Trade Board in the above-mentioned Notice Q. (30) to be the normal number of hours of work in the trade.

## PART III.

APPLICATION OF PROPOSED MINIMUM RATES.

The above Proposed Minimum Rates of Wages shall apply, subject to the provisions of the Trade Boards Acts, to all female workers who are employed as Dippers in respect of all time during which they are employed in Great Britain in any branch of the trade specified in the Appendix to the Trade Boards (Stamped or Pressed Metal Wares) Order, 1924, as set out in Part III of the above-mentioned Notice Q. (30).
