"And whereas the said grant of the said yearly sum of £200 will, after the publication in the London Gazette of an Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme, be made and secured by an Instrument to be executed by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, under our Common Seal, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of the 29th and 30th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 111:

"And whereas there has been contributed and paid to the credit of our account at the Bank of England a capital sum of £2,000 towards the cost of erecting a permanent Church for the said proposed separate District:

"And whereas the said capital sum of  $\pounds 2,000$  has been contributed and paid as aforesaid upon the understanding and condition that (such arrangement appearing to us to be expedient) the whole right of Patronage of the said proposed District, and, when such District shall have become a New Parish, then of the said New Parish, and the nomination of the Minister or Incumbent thereof should be assigned in the manner which is hereinafter set forth:

"And whereas the contributors of the said capital sum of £2,000 towards the cost of erecting such permanent Church have nominated to us the Bishop for the time being of the said Diocese of Rochester as the person to whom they desire that the whole right of Patronage of the said proposed District or New Parish should be assigned:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend John Reginald now Bishop of Rochester, and with the consent of the Right Reverend Cyril Forster, now Bishop of Southwark (in testimony whereof they have signed this Scheme and sealed the same with their respective Episcopal Seals), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly recommend and propose that all those portions of the said New Parish of Christ Church, Bexley Heath, of the said Parish of Bexley, of the said New Parish of the Holy Trinity, Lamor-bey, and of the said Parish of East Wickham which are described in the Schedule hereunder written, all which portions together with the boundaries thereof are delineated and set forth on the map or plan hereunto annexed, shall, upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme as aforesaid become and be constituted a separate District for spiritual purposes, and that the same shall 'The District of Saint John. be named Welling,' and that such District shall be included in and shall form part of the Rural Deanery of Dartford, of the Archdeaconry of Rochester, and of the said Diocese of Rochester.

"And we further recommend and propose that the whole right of Patronage of the said District so recommended to be constituted and, when such District shall have become a New Parish as aforesaid, then of the said New Parish, and the nomination of the Minister or Incumbent thereof shall without any assurance in the law other than this Scheme and any duly gazetted Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying the same and upon and from the day of the date of the publication

of such Order in the London Gazette as aforesaid be assigned to and be absolutely vested in the said John Reginald, Bishop of the said Diocese of Rochester, and his successors for ever.

"And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts, or of any of them, or of any other Act of Parliament.

"THE SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme has reference.

"The District of Saint John, Welling, comprising :----

" All those contiguous portions of the New Parish (sometime District Chapelry) of Christ Church, Bexley Heath, of the Parish of Bexley, of the New Parish (sometime Particular District) of the Holy Trinity, Lamorbey, all in the County of Kent and in the Diocese of Rochester, and of the Parish of East Wickham, in the said County of Kent and in the Diocese of Southwark, which, taken together, are bounded upon the west partly by the New Parish of the Holy Trinity, Eltham, and partly by the District Chapelry of Saint Luke, Well Hall, Eltham, in the said County of Kent and in the said Diocese of Southwark, upon a small part of the north by the New Parish of Christ Church, Shooter's Hill, in the said County of Kent and in the said Diocese of Southwark, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the remaining part of the north, upon the east, and upon the south, by an imaginary line commencing at the point in the middle of Dover Road opposite to the milestone indicating 9 miles from London Bridge where the boundaries of the said New Parish of Christ Church, Shooter's Hill, the said Parish of East Wickham, and the said New Parish of Christ Church, Bexley Heath, all meet, and extending thence south eastward along the boundary which divides the said Parish of East Wickham from the said New Parish of Christ Church, Bexley Heath (thereby following the middle of Dover Road) for a distance of 53 chains or thereabouts to the centre of the bridge which carries the Bexley Heath line of the Southern Railway across Dover Road, and extending thence first north eastward and then eastward along the middle of the said line of railway (thereby crossing the boundary which divides the said Parish of East Wickham from the said New Parish of Christ Church, Bexley Heath) for a distance of 1 mile and 28 chains or thereabouts to the centre of the bridge which carries Brampton Road across such line of railway, and extending thence south westward along the middle of Brampton Road for a distance of 26 chains or thereabouts to its junction with the road called Crook Log, and extending thence south eastward along the middle of the last mentioned road for a distance of 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> chains or thereabouts to its junction with Dallin Road, and extending thence southward along the middle of Dallin Road for a distance of  $16\frac{1}{2}$ chains or thereabouts to its present southern end, and continuing thence southward in precisely the same direction as the latter part
