**COLWYN BAY URBAN DISTRICT  
COUNCIL GAS SPECIAL ORDER.**

(Power to supply gas in the parish of Penrhyn and part of the parish of Llangwstenin in the County of Carnarvon and in the parish of Llansantffraid Glan Conway in the County of Denbigh; Additional lands for the manufacture and storage of gas; Further provisions as to supply of gas; Borrowing of money; Incorporation, Repeal and Amendment of Acts and other matters.)

**N**OTICE is hereby given that the Colwyn Bay Urban District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") whose address is the Council Offices, Colwyn Bay, intend to apply forthwith to the Board of Trade under and in pursuance of the Gas Regulation Act 1920, for a Special Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

1. To extend the limits within which the Council are authorised to supply gas by the addition thereto of the following parishes and part of a parish:—

In the County of Carnarvon:—

The parish of Penrhyn and the following part of the parish of Llangwstenin, namely:—

The portion of the parish lying on the easterly and northerly side of an imaginary line drawn from the point where the boundary of the borough of Conway meets the fence of Tynyfelin farm opposite the quarry situate to the north of Marl Bach thence in a north-easterly direction along the said fence on to the Pydew Mountain thence in a south-easterly direction along the easterly fence of Esgyryn farm thence in a south-westerly direction to the footpath leading from Esgyryn Farm along such footpath to the north fence of the field immediately at the rear of Pensarn Schools thence along the easterly boundary of such field to the County boundary on the northerly side of the London Midland and Scottish Railway and thence along the County boundary in an easterly direction to the point where the County boundary intersects the boundary lines of the parishes of Llangwstenin Llandrilloyn-Rhos and Llansantffraid Glan Conway.

In the County of Denbigh:—

The parish of Llansantffraid Glan Conway.

and to authorise the Council within the said parishes and part of a parish to exercise all or any of the powers rights privileges and authorities with reference to supply and distribution of gas, and the opening and breaking up of streets, roads and ways which are exercisable by them within their existing limits of supply.

2. To provide that the price to be charged by the Council for gas supplied by them within the said parishes and part of a parish to persons who shall burn gas by meter may exceed the price charged to persons in the Colwyn Bay Urban District by ten pence per one thousand cubic feet.

3. To authorise the Council upon the land in the parish of Llansantffraid Glan Conway in the Rural District of Conway in the County of Denbigh hereinafter described, or some part or parts thereof, to erect and maintain, alter, extend, renew, improve or discontinue works for the manufacture, storage, conversion, utilisation and distribution of gas and residual products arising from such manufacture, and to make and store gas, and to make, store, purchase, utilise and distribute all such residual products and materials as aforesaid, and upon such land to construct and maintain houses, buildings, and other works connected with their gas undertaking. The land hereinbefore referred to is included within the following limits:—

(a) The easterly boundary of the foot of the embankment of the London Midland and Scottish Railway from a point 84 yards south-south-west of the southerly corner of the road leading to Llansantffraid Glan Conway Rectory from the road between Conway and Llansantffraid Glan Conway to a point 90 yards south of the first mentioned point;

(b) An imaginary straight line drawn from the point first described in a due easterly direction to the south-westerly side of the said road between Conway and Llansantffraid Glan Conway;

(c) An imaginary straight line drawn due east from the point secondly described to the south-westerly side of the said last-mentioned road; and (d) The south-westerly side of the said last-mentioned road between the points where the said imaginary lines meet it.

4. To make further provision with regard to the purchase and utilisation of residual products on the existing gas lands of the Council; the purchase of additional lands; the laying of pipes for ancillary purposes; the construction and placing of pipes etc., to be laid on consumers' premises; the cutting off and re-connecting supplies and expenses thereof; the supply of gas where the consumer has a separate supply; the register of a prepayment meter being prima facie evidence; the charges for special readings of meters; the removal of fittings where gas supply is discontinued; the provision of anti-fluctuators in connection with gas engines; the provision of a valve where high pressure air is used; bulk supplies to and from local authorities, companies or persons beyond the limits of supply; the relief from
