	<i>Yorkshire (North Riding).</i>
	The buildings and yards at 13 Westgate being part of Coronation Farm, in the occupation of Samuel Booth, in the parish of Old Malton, in the administrative county of the North Riding of Yorkshire.
	The buildings and lands known as Eden House Farm, in the occupation of Sydney Clayton Lynsley, in the parish of Malton in the administrative county of the North Riding of Yorkshire.
