Alteration of Acts.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 4TH JUNE, 1926.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Application of Part II of Sheep (Double Dipping) Order of 1920.

1. Part II (*Double Dipping of Sheep in a Double Dipping Area*) of the Sheep (Double Dipping) Order of 1920, hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order," is hereby applied to the Area described in the Schedule hereto, which shall be a Double Dipping Area for the purposes of that Order.
