FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE DECLARA-  
TION OF INFECTED AREAS ORDER OF  
1926 (No. 77).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Release of Certain Areas from Restrictions.*

1. The Infected Area (No. 2) described in the Schedule to the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Declaration of Infected Areas Order of 1926 (No. 74) and the Infected Area described in the Schedule to the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Declaration of Infected Areas Order of 1926

(No. 75), shall cease to be Infected Areas for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925.

*Commencement and Short Title.*

2. This Order shall come into operation on the eleventh day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, and may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE DECLARATION OF INFECTED AREAS ORDER OF 1926 (No. 77).

ORDER DEFINING THE BENEFITS  
OR ADVANTAGES WHICH MAY BE  
RECKONED AS PAYMENT OF WAGES  
IN LIEU OF PAYMENT IN CASH.

The Lancashire Agricultural Wages Committee, in pursuance of the powers vested in them by the Agricultural Wages (Regulation) Act, 1924, and the Regulations made thereunder do by this Order vary as from June 14th, 1926, their Order of 27th February, 1925, defining the benefits or advantages (not being benefits or advantages prohibited by law) which may be reckoned as payment of wages in lieu of payment in cash for the purpose of the application of any minimum rate of wages fixed by the said Committee for the area comprising the administrative county of Lancaster which for the purposes of the said Act shall be deemed to include the cities and county boroughs of Liverpool and Manchester and the county boroughs of Blackburn, Blackpool, Bolton, Bootle, Burnley, Bury, Oldham, Preston, Rochdale, St. Helens, Salford, Southport, Warrington and Wigan, but excluding the Ulverston Rural District and the Grange, Ulverston and Dalton-in-Furness Urban Dis-

tricts which are deemed to be included in the administrative counties of Cumberland and Westmorland, and hereby order that such benefits or advantages and the values at which they are to be reckoned shall be as follows:—

1. *Benefits or Advantages.*

- (a) Milk.
- (b) Potatoes.
- (c) Lodging.
- (d) Board (including washing but not including intoxicating drink).
- (e) Cottage (including any garden provided with the cottage) except where the cottage is one in regard to which the Medical Officer of Health has reported that it is in a state so dangerous or injurious to health as to be unfit for human habitation.

2. *Values.*

- (a) Milk—4d. per quart.
- (b) Potatoes—8d. per stone.
- (c) and (d) Board and Lodging—
