##### IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 7 of the aforesaid London Traffic Act to make Regulations further amending the London Traffic (Restricted Streets) Regulations with respect to streets which by the London Traffic (Restricted Streets) Orders, 1925, have been declared by the Minister of Transport to be "restricted streets."

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency the Minister of Transport has, under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made the London Traffic (Restricted Streets) Provisional Regulations Amendment (No. 2), 1926, to come into operation forthwith as provisional regulations to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.

#### ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 15TH JULY, 1926.)

#### FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE DECLARATION OF INFECTED AREAS ORDER OF 1926 (No. 87)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

##### *Contraction of Certain Infected Area.*

1. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease Declaration of Infected Areas Order of 1926 (No. 86) shall be read and have effect as if the Area described in the Schedule to this Order were substituted for the Infected Area (No. 9) described in the Schedule to that Order.

##### *Revocation of Certain Order.*

2. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Montague Street (Birmingham) Pig Market) Order of 1926 is hereby revoked.

##### *Commencement.*

3. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-second day of July, nineteen hundred and twenty-six.

##### *Short Title.*

4. This Order may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE DECLARATION OF INFECTED AREAS ORDER OF 1926 (No. 87).
