## TRADE BOARDS.

### MILK DISTRIBUTIVE TRADE.

THE TRADE BOARDS (MILK DISTRIBUTIVE) ORDER, 1920, SPECIAL ORDER, DATED \_\_\_\_\_, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF LABOUR UNDER SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF THE TRADE BOARDS ACT, 1918 (8 & 9 GEO. 5, c. 32) ALTERING THE DESCRIPTION OF THE MILK DISTRIBUTIVE TRADE CONTAINED IN THE APPENDIX TO THE TRADE BOARDS (MILK DISTRIBUTIVE) ORDER, 1920.

Whereas the Minister of Labour (hereinafter referred to as the Minister) by a Special Order called the Trade Board (Milk Distributive) Order, 1920(a), dated the ninth day of January, 1920, applied the Trade Boards Acts, 1909 and 1918 (b), to the trade specified in the Appendix to the said Special Order;

And whereas it is provided by Sub-section 1 of Section 2 of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, that every Special Order may be varied or revoked by a subsequent Special Order;

And whereas the Minister is of opinion that it is desirable to vary the said Special Order by altering the description of the trade specified in the Appendix thereto.

Now, therefore, the Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred on him by the Trade Boards Acts, 1909 and 1918, and of any other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes a Special Order varying the said Special Order:—

1. There shall be inserted in paragraph 2 (a) (iv) of the Appendix to the Trade Boards (Milk Distributive) Order, 1920:—

after the word "pasteurizing" the words "homogenizing, sterilizing."

2. The following new paragraph shall be added to the Appendix to the said Order after paragraph 2, that is to say:—

"3. For the purposes of this Appendix the expression 'fresh milk' shall include sterilized milk."

3. This Order may be cited as the Trade Boards (Milk Distributive) Order, 1920.
