AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 28TH JULY, 1926.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

The Order described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked, and the petty sessional

division of Overton in the county of Flint shall thereupon be deemed to form part of the area to which the provisions of the Sheep (Double Dipping) Order of 1920 were applied by Order of the Minister No. 4249, dated 31st May, 1926.
