SCHEDULE.

Rural District of the Isle of Wight.

1. Cliff Road, Totland Bay, from its junction with Turf Walk and Eden Road to its junction with Alum Bay Road (B.3322) near Headdon Warren.
2. Road from its junction with Alum Bay Road (B.3322) via York Road, Hurst Hill, Summers Lane and Sheepwash to its junction with the Alum Bay-Freshwater Bay Road at Middleton Corner.
3. Road known as the Causeway from the Freshwater-Newport Road (A.3055) at Afton Farm to All Saints Church, Freshwater.
4. Road from the road junction about 300 yards south of Calbourne Lower Mill, via Quarry Lane, Stone Steps Cross, Five Houses and Pump Lane, to its junction with the Newport-Calbourne Road about 500 yards north-east of Newbarn.
5. Road known as Upper Lane, Brighstone, from its junction with Moortown Lane at Fortunes Corner to its junction with the Shorwell-Brook Road (A.3055) about 330 yards east of Rowdown Lane.
6. Road known as Galley Lane, Mill Lane and Broad Lane, from its junction with the Shorwell-Brook Road (A.3055) about 75 yards north of Drapers, via Marsh Green and Waytes Court, to its junction with the Shorwell-Brook Road about 170 yards east of Brighstone Church.
7. Road from the Brighstone-Shorwell Road (A.3055) at Limerstone Farm, via Yafford, Yafford House, Little Atherfield, Atherfield Green, Pyle and Walpan Farm, to its junction with the Shorwell-Blackgang Road (A.3055) at St. Andrews Church, Chale, including the branch from Pyle, via Newman Lane, to its junction with the Shorwell-Blackgang Road (A.3055) at the Methodist Chapel, Chale.
8. Road known as St. Lawrence Shute from its junction with the Whitwell-Ventnor Road (B.3327) at Week Cross to the Railway Station at St. Lawrence.

9. Road known as Bonchurch Shute from its junction with the Shanklin-Ventnor Road (A.3055), via Bonchurch Hotel, The Rectory and Fishpond, to the boundary of the Urban District of Ventnor.

10. Road from the Newport-Shanklin Road (A.3056) at the Square, Godshill, via Church Road, Sainham and Sheepwash, to its junction with the Godshill-Whitwell Road (B.3327) about 400 yards north of Smarts Cross.

11. Road from the Sandown-Ryde Road (A.3023) at Morton Manor, Brading, via Adgestone, Alverstone and Queen's Bower, to the Road junction at Winford Cross and the road from the Horryngford-Branstone Road (A.3020) at Fighting Cocks Cross, via Bathingbourne, Lessland Corner, Redhill Lane and Appuldurcombe, to its junction with St. John's Road, Wroxall, near the Schools, Wroxall.

12. Road known as Hillway Road and Howgate Lane, Bembridge, from the Yaverland-Lane End Road, near Bembridge Farm, via Stanwell Farm and Howgate Farm, to its junction with the road leading to "The Crab and Lobster" Inn, Forelands.

13. Road from the Ryde-Sandown Road (A.3023) at Whitefields Wood Cross, via Truckles and Hardingshute, to its junction with West Lane; and from Green Lane, via Nunwell Cottages, to its junction with the Ryde-Ashley Down Road at the Lodge, East Ashley.

14. Road known as Sandy Way, Blackwater, from the Newport-Chillerton Road at Cox's Corner near the Asylum, to its junction with the Newport-Ventnor Road (A.3056) at Blackwater Station.

15. Road from the Newport-Ventnor Road (A.3020) near Shide Railway Station, via Burnt House Lane, to its junction with the Downend-Arreton Road at the Chalk Pit.

16. Road known as Whippingham-Wootton Road from Dallimore Cottages to its junction with the Ryde-Newport Road (A.3022) at the Gravel Pit, Smithclose.

17. Road known as Pallance Lane, Northwood, from the road junction near Northwood Schools at Furzyhurst, via Pallance Farm, to its junction with Pallance Road near the Chapel.

18. *Urban District of Cowes.*—Cockleton Lane from its junction with Place Road (B.3325) and Pallance Road, via Upper Cockleton to its junction with Solent View Road at Gurnard Marsh.

19. *Urban District of East Cowes.*—Esplanade Road from its junction with the Esplanade and Cambridge Road to the Bathing House at Old Castle Point.

20. *Borough of Newport.*—Whitepit Lane from its junction with Castle Road (B.3341) to its junction with St. John's Road and Watergate Road at Shide Cross.

21. *Urban District of St. Helens.*—Bullen Road from its junction with Marlborough Road (A.3023) to its junction with the Ryde-St. Helens Road (B.3331) at Uplands.

22. Duver Road from the road junction at Eddington Corner to St. Helens Duver.

23. Latimer Road from its junction with Lower Green Road to its junction with Station Road.
