Declaration of Infected Areas Order of 1926 (No. 84), shall be read and have effect as if the Area described in the Schedule to this Order were substituted for the Infected Area (No. 7) described in the Schedule to that Order.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the tenth day of August, nineteen hundred and twenty-six.

Short Title.

3. This Order may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE DECLARATION OF INFECTED AREAS ORDER OF 1926 (No. 92).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

- 1. An Inspector of the Ministry may, for the purpose of preventing the spreading of Foot-and-Mouth Disease, by Notice served upon the occupier of Hockford Farm, in the parish of Pirbright, in the administrative county of Surrey, direct the removal of the animals:—
 - (a) from the pastures to enclosed yards, sheds, styes or other suitable buildings available for the purpose on the said premises, or

- (b) from the pastures in which the animals are at the time of the service of the Notice to other pastures in the same occupation
- 2. Animals moved in accordance with such Notice shall be kept by the owner or person in charge thereof in the place specified in the Notice until such Notice is withdrawn.
- 3. Any Notice served under this Order shall remain in force until it is withdrawn by a further Notice of an Inspector of the Ministry.
- 4. Copies of any Notices served under this Order shall forthwith be sent by the Inspector serving the same, to the Ministry and also to the Local Authority.
