LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1918.

YAXLEY FEN (THIRD DISTRICT) DRAINAGE  
AREA (HUNTS.).

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has prepared a draft Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1918, constituting lands drained by such part of the Black Ham Drain or River as lies between Mile Drove Yaxley and Conquest Lode or by the tributaries or drains connected therewith in the County of Huntingdon, a separate Drainage District under the Land Drainage Acts, 1861 and 1918.

A copy of the draft Order and of a 6-inch scale map showing the proposed drainage district has been deposited at the Office of Mr. George Keeble, Estate Agent, Cowgate, Peterborough, for public inspection, for the period of thirty days from the date hereof. Copies of the draft Order (without the map) may be obtained from the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries at the address mentioned below at the price of 1s. per copy.

Any objection to the draft Order should be made in writing and sent by post to the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries at the address mentioned below so as to reach that Office within thirty days from the date hereof.

INCOME TAX.

Whereas it is provided by the Income Tax Acts that every person who is intrusted with the payment of any dividends which are payable to any person in Great Britain or Northern Ireland out of any public revenue other than that of Great Britain and Northern Ireland; or who has intrusted to him any interest, dividends, or other annual payment payable out of or in respect of the stocks, funds, shares, or securities of any foreign or colonial company, society, adventure, or concern for payment to any person in Great Britain or Northern Ireland; or who has intrusted to him any annuities, pensions, or other annual sums payable out of the funds of any institution in India for payment to any person in Great Britain or Northern Ireland, shall, within one month after being so required by notice published in the Gazette, deliver to His Majesty's Commissioners of Inland Revenue an account in writing, giving his name and residence, and a description of the dividends, interest, annuities, pensions, or other annual payments or sums intrusted to him for payment; and

whereas by the said Acts it is further provided that any person who neglects or refuses to deliver any such account as aforesaid shall forfeit the sum of one hundred pounds over and above the tax chargeable on any such dividends, interest, annuities, pensions, or other annual payments or sums, notice is hereby given to all persons intrusted with the payment of any such dividends, interest, annuities, pensions, or other annual payments or sums as aforesaid that the accounts of the said dividends, etc., required by the said Acts are to be delivered in writing to His Majesty's Commissioners of Inland Revenue at Somerset House, in the County of Middlesex, addressed to their Secretary, within the space of one month from the date hereof.

ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR GENERAL  
IN ENGLAND.

(Dated 4th August, 1926.)

Whereas under Section 21 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, the Registrar General, with the sanction of the Minister of Health, may from time to time alter Registration Sub-districts:—

Now, therefore, I, Sylvanus Percival Vivian, C.B., Registrar General of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in England, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Births and Deaths Registration Acts, 1836 to 1901, and with the sanction of the Minister of Health, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Camberwell Registration of Births, etc. (Alteration of Sub-districts) Order, 1926, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of September, 1926.

2. The existing East Dulwich Sub-district of Camberwell Registration District shall be extended by the addition of Dulwich Sub-district of the same Registration District and the extended Sub-district shall be known by the name of the Dulwich Sub-district.

3. The Registrar of the existing East Dulwich Sub-district shall be the Registrar of the Dulwich Sub-district constituted by this Order.
