IMPORTATION OF DOGS (AMENDMENT)
ORDER OF 1926.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Amendment of Paragraph 2 of Article 1 of
Importation of Dogs Order of 1914.*

1. Paragraph 2 of Article 1 of the Importation of Dogs Order of 1914 as amended by the Importation of Dogs (Amendment) Order of 1923, is hereby revoked and the following paragraph is substituted therefor:—

“(2) The provisions of this Order shall also apply to a dog taken from Great Britain, Ireland, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man, into any port in any other country, (except Great Britain, Ireland, the Channel Islands, and the Isle of Man), as if the animal were an imported dog, and also to any dog which has, at any time before or after arrival at a port in Great Britain, been in contact with any imported dog as defined in this Order ”.

Revocation.

2. The Importation of Dogs (Amendment) Order of 1923 is hereby revoked.

Commencement

3. This Order shall come into operation on the fifteenth day of September, nineteen hundred and twenty-six.

Short Title and Construction.

4. This Order may be cited as the IMPORTATION OF DOGS (AMENDMENT) ORDER OF 1926 and shall be read with the Importation of Dogs Order of 1914 and the Importation of Dogs (Amendment) Order of 1918 (No. 2).

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (DECLARATION OF INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1926 (No. 94).
