URBAN DISTRICT OF THORNTON.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, 1925.

BY an Order dated the 9th day of August, 1926, the Minister of Health has :—

(i) repealed the following provisions of certain local Acts in force in the Urban District for the purpose of bringing that Act into conformity with the Public Health Act, 1925, namely :—

The Thornton Urban District Gas Act, 1906—Section 15;

The Thornton Urban District Council Act, 1923—Sections 42 and 43, and so much of Section 49 as relates to any subject matter of Section 72 of the Public Health Act, 1925; and

(ii) consented to the adoption by the Urban District Council of Thornton of Sections 22 (preventing soil &c. from being washed into streets), 44 (offensive trades) and the sections contained in Part V (watercourses &c.) of the Public Health Act, 1925, to take effect on the 30th day of August, 1926.

A copy of the Order may be inspected at the Council Offices, Blackpool Road, Thornton, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on any weekday other than Saturday, and on Saturday between the hours of 10 a.m. and 12 noon.
