THE HEYSHAM AND MORECAMBE BAY (SHELL-FISH) REGULATIONS, 1926.

Notice is hereby given, under Section 3 (3) of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that the above-named Regulations, 1926, dated the 9th day of October, 1926, prohibiting the sale or distribution for human consumption of mussels taken from the beds prescribed in the Regulations, unless and until they have been subjected to an approved cleansing process, have been made by the Minister of Health, and are published as Statutory Rules and Orders, 1926, No. 1206.
