

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 19TH OCTOBER, 1926.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Order of the Minister dated the 7th July, 1925, and numbered 3983, exempting a certain field (No. 502 on the Ordnance Survey Map) at South Cottesloe Farm in the parish of Wing, Buckinghamshire, and the sheep thereon, from the provisions of the Sheep Scab Order of 1920, subject to certain conditions, sheep may be grazed or kept on either of the two fields numbered 501 and 506 on the Ordnance Survey Map adjoining the first mentioned field at South Cottesloe Farm, and any such sheep may be moved from the said fields numbered 501 and 506 to the said field numbered 502 for the purpose of being dipped, and back again to the fields (numbered 501 or 506) from which they were moved for that purpose.

2. Any sheep grazed or kept on either of the two fields numbered 501 or 506 aforesaid shall not be removed off the said premises known as South Cottesloe Farm except by licence granted by an Inspector of the Ministry, and then only for the purpose of being moved direct either to a slaughterhouse or to the Metropolitan Cattle Market, Islington, subject to such conditions as may be specified in the licence.

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (DECLARATION OF INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1926 (No. 119).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Release of Middlesex Infected Area from Restrictions.

1. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area (No. 4) described in the First Schedule to the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Declaration of Infected Areas) Order of 1926 (No. 116) shall cease to be an Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925.

Commencement and Short Title.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-seventh day of October, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, and may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (DECLARATION OF INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1926 (No. 119).

Alteration of Acts.

Notice is hereby given that the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries has prepared a draft Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1918, supplementing the Acts of Parliament under which the above Commissioners act for the more effectual drainage of the District under their jurisdiction by extending the powers of the Commissioners in relation to borrowing and the levying of taxes.
