## CLAYTON ELECTRICITY SPECIAL ORDER, 1926.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Electricity Commissioners have submitted to the Minister of Transport for confirmation under the above-mentioned Acts a Special Order made by them for the supply by the Urban District Council of Clayton of electricity within the Urban District of Clayton in the West Riding of the County of York.

The Minister of Transport proposes to confirm the Order and gives notice that any person affected who may be desirous of objecting to the confirmation of the same must in accordance with the Electricity (Confirmation of Special Orders) Rules 1921, do so by memorial addressed to the Minister of Transport written on one side only of foolscap paper and sent by registered post addressed to The Secretary, Ministry of Transport, 6, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1, and posted not later than the 17th day of November, 1926. A copy of any such memorial must also be sent in like

manner to Frederic H. Richardson, Esq., 24, Bank Street, Bradford, Solicitor, or to Messrs. Lees & Company, Palace Chambers, Bridge Street, Westminster, London, S.W. 1, Parliamentary Agents for the Order. Such memorial must be sealed or signed by the person objecting or by some responsible and duly authorised person on his behalf and must state the specific grounds of objection to the Order and the modifications desired.

Copies of the Order as submitted for confirmation may be obtained at a price not exceeding two shillings each at the office of the Clayton Urban District Council, Council Offices, Clayton, and at the offices of the before-mentioned Solicitor and Parliamentary Agents.
