1926. 4th November ...	<i>Somerset.</i> The fields known as Big Hill Field, Collins Hill Field and Church Close, together with the buildings situate therein, in the occupation of George Edward Coleberd, in the parish of South Barrow, in the administrative county of Somerset.
	<i>Warwickshire.</i> The premises known as Mason's Lodge Farm, Alcester Road, Stratford-on-Avon, in the administrative county of Warwick, in the occupation of Edward Henry Austin.
8th November ...	<i>Somerset.</i> The buildings situate on the East side of the road leading from North Cadbury to Castle Carey, together with the fields known as Home Field, Six-acre Field, Hill Orchard, Higher side Marsh, Lower side Marsh, Rough-Ground, Lower Six-acre Field, Five-acre Orchard, Long Close and Seven-acre Field, all forming part of Hill Farm, in the occupation of Berkeley Watts, in the parish of North Cadbury, in the administrative county of Somerset.

## FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (DECLARATION OF INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1926 (No. 123).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Declaration of Further Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area.*

1. The Area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area for the pur-

poses of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Declaration of Infected Areas) Order of 1926 (No. 116) shall be read and have effect as if the Area described in the Schedule hereto were included as Area No. 6 in the First Schedule to that Order.

*Short Title.*

2. This Order may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (DECLARATION OF INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1926 (No. 123) and shall be read with the Orders referred to in Article 1.
