Whereas under Section 21 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, the Registrar General, with the sanction of the Minister of Health, may from time to time alter Registration Sub-districts:—

Now, therefore, I, Sylvanus Percival Vivian, C.B., Registrar General of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in England, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Births and Deaths Registration Acts, 1836 to 1901, and with the sanction of the Minister of Health, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Petworth Registration of Births, etc. (Alteration of Sub-districts) Order, 1926, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of December, 1926.

2. The existing Wisborough Green Subdistrict of Petworth Registration District shall be extended by the addition of Petworth Sub-district of the same Registration District and the extended Sub-district shall be known by the name of the Petworth Subdistrict. 3. The Registrar of the existing Wisborough Green Sub-district shall be the Registrar of the Petworth Sub-district constituted by this Order.

And whereas it is expedient that a corresponding alteration should be made in the constitution of the Registration Sub-districts hereinafter mentioned :—
