"(2) The rates shown above to apply to Officers of the classes indicated who (a) were immediately prior to promotion to Warrant or higher rank, in receipt of the revised rates of substantive pay instituted for certain men with effect from the 5th October, 1925, or (b) entered or may enter direct into the Royal Marines or Royal Naval Reserve as Officers after the 16th October, 1926.

"(3) The standard rates of full pay and half pay established by this Order shall be comparable with those established by Order in Council of the 22nd January, 1920, and shall be subject to revision at the same dates and in the same manner; likewise the current rates of full pay and half pay established by this Order shall be comparable with those established by Order in Council of the 16th December, 1925, and shall be subject to further review on or after the 1st day of July, 1927."

**W**HEREAS it is provided by subsection (2) of section thirty-six of the Finance Act, 1926, that it shall be lawful for His Majesty in Council by Order to make such amendments of the forms of statements, lists and declarations contained in the Fifth Schedule to the Income Tax Act, 1918, as appear to His Majesty to be necessary to give effect to the provisions of Part IV of the said Act and that

the said Schedule shall have effect as amended by any Order so made:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, in pursuance of the said enactment, is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. The amendments set out in the Schedule to this Order shall be made in the Fifth Schedule to the Income Tax Act, 1918, and the said Fifth Schedule shall have effect as amended by this Order.

2. This Order may be cited as the Income Tax (Schedule V Amendment) Order, 1927.
