ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR GENERAL
IN ENGLAND.

(Dated 24th March, 1927.)

Whereas under Section 21 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, the Registrar General, with the sanction of the Minister of Health, may from time to time alter Registration Sub-districts:—

And whereas by the Bishopstoke Order, 1927, it is provided that, on the 1st April, 1927, the Parish of Bishopstoke shall be separated from the Winchester Union and shall be added to and form part of the South Stoneham Union, and that the latter Union shall be re-named the Eastleigh Union.

And whereas it is expedient that a corresponding alteration should be made in the constitution of the Registration Sub-districts hereinafter mentioned:—

Now, therefore, I, Sylvanus Percival Vivian, C.B., Registrar General of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in England, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Births and Deaths Registration Acts, 1836 to 1901, and with the sanction of the Minister of Health, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Winchester and South Stoneham Registration of Births, &c. (Alteration of Sub-districts) Order, 1927, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1927.

2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Civil Parish of Bishopstoke, which, on the 1st April, 1927, will be transferred by the recited Order to the South Stoneham Union, shall cease to form part of the Twyford Sub-district of Winchester Registration District, and shall be added to and form part of the South Stoneham Sub-district of South Stoneham Registration District.

4. The existing South Stoneham Registration District as extended by this Order shall be re-named the Eastleigh Registration District.

5. The existing South Stoneham Sub-district as extended by this Order shall be re-named the Eastleigh Sub-district.

6. The Superintendent Registrar of the existing South Stoneham Registration District and the Registrar of the existing South Stoneham Sub-district shall, respectively, be the Superintendent Registrar and Registrar of the same Registration District and Sub-district as extended and re-named by this Order.
